1. Mayor Pro Tempore Joe Frazier opened the meeting.

2. PRESENTATION OF THE 2023 GENERAL ELECTION RESULTS:

City Recorder Rydalch presented the results including 939 registered voters in Oakley City. Total ballots cast of 486 with voter turnout of 51.75%. There are two precincts in Oakley. Turnout for precis Oakley 14-10 was 42% and for Oakley 14-25 it was 60%.

The ballots for each candidate for City Council were:

Dave Neff received the most with 364 votes

Joe Frazier received 322 votes

Tom Smart received 224 votes

Kelly Edwards received 183 votes
Kerbee Leavitt Atkinson received 174 votes.

The vacant offices were for three City Council seats. The top three candidates that received the most votes will fill those offices beginning January 1st, 2025. Those candidates are Dave Neff, Joe Frazier, and Tom Smart.

There were 17 ballots rejected, consisting of three unsigned ballots, nine postmarked after the deadline, and five with signatures that could not be verified.


There were a total of 185 ballots that were under voted and 6 that were overvoted.


3. RESOLUTION 2023-08 CANVASS OF THE 2023 OAKLEY MUNICIPAL GENERAL ELECTION RESULTS.
