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35	2. PUBLIC COMMENT:

38	Kelly Edwards, 246 West 4400 North, Oakley UT: "I just want to voice my concern of Dutch's of
39	service. I'm hearing things from people. Stating the fact that where I'm to be announced here
40	soon. TBD To be announced? What's going to happen to our corner? That's a concern. I have not

been contacted by any official person to determine what we're going to do with our corner. So I'm concerned. That's all I have to say. Thank you."

Mayor Woolstenhulme: "I appreciate that. Um. So we need to make note of that in case anyone says anything. I expect if there is an announcement, you'll be the one to make it."

No Additional Comment was Received.

3. COMMUNITY INVOLVEMENT DISCUSSION:

Mayor Woolstenhulme reminded Council of the City's donation in FY 2025 to the Kamas Veterans Memorial. **Terina Darcy,** who is coordinating the installation of the memorial was present to get the information the Council wanted inscribed on the memorial bench. Council decided that they would give this consideration and have an inscription for her in two weeks to take to the engraver for design options.

Recorder Rydalch addressed the Council on behalf of the Community Action Center (Food Pantry) and their request to have a Councilmember sit on their General Board based out of Provo, Utah. Councilmember Smart indicated that there might be a perceived conflict of interest due to the City already subsidizing their use of space in the City Hall facility. Other Councilmembers stated their support of the service but indicated that the time commitment outside of our local community was problematic. The Council opted not to accept the Board invitation.

4. CONSERVANCY CONSIDERATION OAKLEY CITY PARCEL OT-270-X

Kate Sattlemeier from Summit Land Conservancy summarized a potential letter of understanding regarding a potential conservation easement on the Oakley City -owned parcel OT-270-X located on the east side of Pinion/Boulderville Road.

The council discussed the conservation easement for 83 acres of land focusing on protecting a watershed area and public recreational trails. They agreed to put the matter on the next council agenda for formal action, which would allow them to proceed with legal documentation and potentially finalize the easement by December.

5. RESOLUTION 2025-06 INTENT TO ANNEX PROPERTY KNOWN AS SUMMIT COUNTY PARCEL cd-258 "DEER MEADOWS RANCH"

Recorder Rydalch presented a resolution with the intent to annex a 11.58-acre property known as Summit County Parcel CD 258. She stated that the parcel is contiguous to Oakley City legal boundaries and is in an existing unincorporated peninsula. She also indicated that the annexation is required as a condition of a previously approved conditional use permit for an event center that sits on two parcels – one within Oakley City and one in unincorporated Summit County. She then explained that the process for this annexation differs from aallowsal

83	annexation because the parcel exists in a peninsula which allows for the City to expedite the
84	process with the county's support to reduce the size of the peninsula. It was discussed that this
85	parcel is also the location of an airstrip for small aircraft and the annexation would require the
86	property owners to apply for a conditional use permit for the airstrip in the AG-40 zone. There
87	were some questions from Council about whether a current county permit for the airstrip would
88	transfer to the city jurisdiction.
89	Councilmember Smart motioned to adopt Resolution 2025-06 Intent to Annex Property Known as
90	Summit County Parcel CD-258 "Deer Meadows Ranch." Councilmember Wilmoth seconded the motion.
