Planner Stephanie Woosltenhulme shares that the Diner Sign Application was sent back to the drawing board. They came back with what Planning Commission was asking for. Signs on building will remain the same size, sign on Weber Canyon Road (free standing sign) is gone, free standing on building sign over vestibule is gone, only difference is sign on SR 32 may be bumped from 20 to 30 square feet which is allowable. Biggest change since Staff Report is bulbs are dimmable too. Signage on back for bottom business will come in later under a different signage permit.

**Richard Bliss** makes a motion to approve the signage information as presented today that is within the allotments for signs numbered previously as 1, 2 & 4. We are open to any possible addendums being presented for any additional signage that is within the square footage allotment or negotiated.
