West Facing:

- Sign 1 = 32.5 sq ft Oakley Roasting Co.
- Sign 2 = 25 sq ft Fiiz Drinks

South Facing:

- Blade Signs = 13 sq ft No lighting
- On wall signage = 32 sq ft No interior lighting. Lit from above.

**Doug Evans** has concerns with 6-foot clearance on blade signs. Does not have issues with the signs because of the mass on the back side.

**Doug Evans** makes a motion that they approve the sign plan as submitted.

Jan Manning seconds the motion.
